Farewell Gordon

On the 22nd March we lost our dear friend and long-time Volunteer Gordon Walker who passed away peacefully at the age of 74.

Gordon was a much-loved volunteer with Rockhampton Meals on Wheels for 45 years. Gordon was a familiar, cheery face on many delivery runs, particulary run 12, 13 and 15.

Gordon started with Meals on Wheels Rockhampton in 1977, over the 45 years that he volunteered he saw the organisation grow from a small service delivering to 30 plus people to grow to over 300 clients and 14 delivery runs throughout Rockhampton and Gracemere.

Gordon was inducted into the Queensland Meals on Wheels Roll of Honour in 2015 for over 38 years of service. This prestigious award is only given to volunteers with more than 30 years service and Gordon was one of the very few through Queensland that were still volunteering today.

Gordon was much loved by everyone - Staff, volunteers and clients. Everyone has their fond stories and memories of him. His absence has been felt greatly and we miss him dearly.
